2. Review ACC's list of concerns regarding the GPP model.

Group discussion of the types of clarifications requested and the issues raised at the ACC meeting last week. We are waiting to hear from Mark Staton about any proposed revisions to the pre-MBA pathway program model. Vicki reported on her communication with the Provost, Cezar Mesquita (Director of Admissions), Clara Capron (AVP for Enrollment & Student Services), and Lauren McConatha (Study Group) about enrollment, admissions, and advising issues raised at ACC that are beyond the purview of the AWG.
3. Revise GPP model (Principles, undergrad pathway model, Guidelines) in response to ACC request for clarification.

Group discussion to clarify aspects of the three documents and to address public perceptions of the AWG's appointed role as part of the GPP planning process. Vicki and Maggie will incorporate proposed changes to the three parts of the GPP model. Vicki will then ask AWG members for their approval of the changes via email so that the revised documents can be submitted to ACC for next week's follow-up discussion.
